This collaborative textile art piece spans 120 feet and is a collection of 263 blocks, each made by an Indigenous person or immigrant to Canada.

The Quilt of Belonging recognizes Canada's diversity and celebrates our common humanity while promoting harmony and compassion among people.

Completed at the turn of the millennium, it was discovered that Canada has an immigrant from every country in the world, truly a place for all.

Projects, crafts and games are available for all grade levels.
